Project: *Dundee & Angus Residual Waste Project*
Client: *Dundee City Council, Angus Council*
Engagement: *January 2013 to date*

Project Summary

Dundee City Council and Angus Council are working in partnership in a joint procurement exercise for a 25 year residual waste management services contract in a project managed and led by Chacefield Associates.



The project is unique in that Dundee City Council already owns an Energy from Waste Plant within the city (leased and operated by Dundee Energy Recycling Limited), and this asset is to form part of the commercial deal with the incoming contractor.

Chacefield Associates has fulfilled the Project leader role in this project since inception in January 2013.

Project Inception

Initially the role entailed leading the Partner Councils through the planning stages of the project. Chacefield Associates assisted to identify potential Partner Councils and then scoped the Project (size and length) in conjunction with those Councils.

Chacefield Associates then authored an Outline Business Case which secured all necessary approvals to proceed within both Partner Councils while also creating an appropriate governance structure for the project.

Project Delivery

To ensure the project governance was robust when introduced to the market Chacefield Associates assisted the Partner Councils to conclude an Inter Authority Agreement for the procurement prior to OJEU.

Chacefield Associates then led the procurement of legal, technical and financial advisors for the project, drafting scopes of work and leading the evaluation of tenders, while also ensuring there were sufficient internal resources allocated to the project.



The project was advertised in OJEU in December 2014. Chacefield Associates is now leading the project through competitive dialogue with the intention of reaching Financial Close in early 2017.
