Project Summary

Glasgow Caledonian University offers a post graduate course in Energy & Environmental Management at their campus in Glasgow.



The programme is designed to give a deeper understanding of the inter-relationships between the environment and topics such as energy technology, environmental law, business strategies, policy and other areas.

It focuses on environmental auditing, assessment and management procedures, as required by industrial and commercial bodies.

Chacefield Associates has provided a lecturer for this programme since March 2012.

Session Content

Chacefield Associates input focusses on waste management infrastructure and covers the practical delivery of sustainable waste management projects.

We develop and deliver a 2 hour lecture plus a one hour tutorial session, with particular emphasis on procurement issues such as:

- sources and implications of financing;
- identification and management of project and programme risks (from pre-procurement through to service commencement, from both a procuring and bidding perspective);
- procurement processes, with a particular emphasis on the Competitive Dialogue process required within the European Union; and
- other commercial considerations, including the factors which influence a company's bidding and pricing decisions.

Delivery Outcomes

The aim of the sessions is to link the theoretical knowledge the students have gained regarding sustainable technologies and waste treatment processes with real-life project and delivery issues.
